Risk Management – Footpath and Cycleway Policy

INTRODUCTION

In order to minimise the potential for 'slip, trip and fall' injuries to occur, Council has developed a risk management approach to Council's footpath and cycleway networks.

Council has recognised that 'slips, trips and falls' associated with footpath and cycleway networks form a significant percentage of public liability claims received by councils within New South Wales.

AIMS OF POLICY

- To support procedures for the inspection, evaluation and maintenance, based on priorities, of footpaths and cycleways.
- To provide a managed level of public safety for users of the footpath and cycleway networks.
- To extend the life of the footpath and cycleway assets by timely maintenance and rehabilitation.

POLICY STATEMENT

- Council will, within its budgetary constraints, provide a level of funding each year to manage network of footpaths and cycleways for pedestrians and cyclists to utilise.
- Council will utilise a risk management approach to the management of its footpath and cycleway assets, based on the Best Practice Manual as developed by Statewide Mutual.
- The policy, together with the procedures, provides the guidelines for managing the network of footpaths and cycleways.

APPLICABILITY

This policy is applicable to footpaths and cycleways surfaced with concrete, asphaltic concrete, bitumen seal or pavers.
