THE GLEN INNES SEVERN LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREA HAS BEEN PLACED ON LEVEL ONE (1) WATER RESTRICTIONS. THIS INCLUDES THE USE OF TOWN WATER FROM THE GLEN INNES AND DEEPWATER WATER SUPPLY SYSTEMS SUCH AS WATER CARTED TO THE VILLAGES.

LEVEL ONE (1) WATER RESTRICTIONS

DOMESTIC

- Garden watering - no watering between 10am and 4pm during daylight saving
- Washing vehicles - no restriction
- Swimming pools - no restriction
- Wash paved areas, outdoor surfaces - no restriction

PUBLIC / COMMERCIAL / INDUSTRIAL

- Public gardens - no restriction
- Sports grounds - no restriction
- Market gardens and orchards - no restriction
- Nurseries and commercial flower gardens - no restriction
- Bowling greens - no restriction
- Fountains - not to be in use between 10am and 4pm during daylight saving
- Household and livestock water cartage from town supply - no restriction
- Ready mixed concrete - no restriction
- Livestock truck wash - no restriction
- Automatic flush toilets - no restriction
