## LEVEL ONE (1) WATER RESTRICTIONS

## **DOMESTIC**

- Garden watering no watering between 10am and 4pm during daylight saving
- · Washing vehicles no restriction
- Swimming pools no restriction
- Wash paved areas, outdoor surfaces no restriction

## PUBLIC / COMMERCIAL / INDUSTRIAL

- Public gardens no restriction
- · Sports grounds no restriction
- · Market gardens and orchards no restriction
- Nurseries and commercial flower gardens no restriction
- · Bowling greens no restriction
- Fountains not to be in use between 10am and 4pm during daylight saving
- Household and livestock water cartage from town supply no restriction
- Ready mixed concrete no restriction
- · Livestock truck wash no restriction
- · Automatic flush toilets no restriction
