



GLEN INNES SEVERN COUNCIL 2023 AUSTRALIA DAY AWARDS

The Award categories for the 2023 Australia Day ceremony are:

<u>Citizen of the Year:</u> The Australia Day Council Plaque and certificate of recognition, Glen Innes Severn Council 'Citizen of the Year' Perpetual Shield (which is kept on display at Council).

<u>Young Citizen of the Year:</u> (26 years or under as of 26 January in the year of the Award presentation): The Australia Day Council Plaque and certificate of recognition, Glen Innes Severn Council 'Young Citizen of the Year' Perpetual Shield (which is kept on display at Council).

<u>Community Event of the Year:</u> The Australia Day Council Plaque and certificate of recognition.

<u>Voluntary Community Organisation of the Year:</u> The Australia Day Council Plaque and certificate of recognition.

Emergency Services Volunteer of the Year: The Australia Day Council Plaque and certificate of recognition.

<u>Environmental Citizen of the Year Awards:</u> The Australia Day Council Plaque and certificate of recognition.

Young environmental Citizen of the year Award (school aged): The Australia Day Council Plague and certificate of recognition.

INDIVIDUAL Junior sportsperson (15 and under as at 26/1/2023): The Australia Day Council Plague and certificate of recognition.

<u>Senior sportsperson and Contribution to Sport:</u> The Australia Day Council Plaque and certificate of recognition.

The aim of these awards is to honour, on Australia Day, the voluntary achievements of fellow citizens, community groups and community events by recognising their outstanding contribution to our community through community or service work, or through individual dedication and contribution to a particular group or the whole community, during any period of time.

Guidelines

- All residents and/or organisations of Glen Innes Severn Local Government Area are eligible for nomination.
- The Glen Innes Severn Council Australia Day Committee will judge the nominations based on the information provided. The Committee's decision shall be final.
- The Committee shall select the Award winners, taking into account the following:
 - outstanding voluntary service to the community;
 - organisations/community activities your nominee volunteers/assists with;
 - number of years/decades given;
 - o any executive roles held.
 - o outstanding voluntary contribution of time and talents to a good cause.
- Nomination forms must be used, attaching information to support your nomination of no more than two (2) x A4 pages. All information should be typed or **clearly** handwritten, otherwise the nomination will not be considered by the Committee.

Nominations will be accepted until 4.30pm on Tuesday, 13 December 2022.
