Due to a technical malfunction with the pool equipment, the Emmaville Swim Centre has ended its season one week earlier than expected.

In the meantime, the Glen Innes Aquatic Centre remains fully operational and has extended its season until 30 April 2025 (excluding public holidays).

Cane Toad Sighting

Council has received a report of a cane toad (Rhinella marina) sighting within the Local Government Area. Cane toads can be identified by their dry, warty skin, large glands behind the eyes, and distinctive hopping movement.

Cane toads can spread through freight, green waste, and timber, potentially establishing new populations that threaten local ecosystems.

If you spot a suspected cane toad, do not touch or move it – instead, report it immediately.

Infrastructure Works Program

The following works are scheduled in the period ending Friday, 4 April 2025 subject to weather conditions and unforeseen delays:

- Jet patching in Glen Innes Township, Old Grafton Road and Strathbogie Road

- Maintenance grading is scheduled Glen Innes Township gravel roads, Fawcett Road, Winters Road, Crotty Road, Six Mile Road, Bargens Road, Severn River Road and Streeters Road

- The Heavy Patching Crew will be undertaking urban heavy patching at various locations as part of the urban heavy patching reseal program and assisting grading teams
