CONDITIONS OF USE OF COUNCIL'S SPORTING FACILITIES

1. Current public liability policy (Certificate of Currency) is attached.
2. That council has been advised and given permission for all activities including training and working bees no matter how short a period.
3. No vehicle is allowed to drive on or across any playing surface. No vehicle is to be parked on any playing surface. The only exemption to this provision is emergency service vehicles.
4. No glass is allowed at sporting fields.
5. No alcohol is allowed without council granting permission.
6. The grounds are to be left in a neat and tidy condition.
7. Your attention is drawn to the fact that you do not have exclusive use of council's facilities.
8. **Under no circumstances is line marking to be carried out with distillate, oil, herbicides, weedicides or any other material which sterilize the soil or damage the soil structure preventing the regrowth of grass.** Line marking is to be carried with a mixture of dye and Round-up providing the marking takes place no later than **six (6) weeks** before the end of the particular sporting season.
9. All non-fixed goal posts or similar structures, which may topple if force is applied, are to be anchored at all times when located in areas accessible by the public to prevent their collapse.
10. All applications for use of grounds and facilities must be submitted one (1) month in advance.
11. Council reserves the right to close any field for renovations, repairs, improvements or if it considers conditions to be unsuitable for the use of the grounds.

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH ANY OF THESE CONDITIONS CAN LEAD TO EVICTION FROM THE GROUNDS AND WILL JEOPARDISE THE GRANTING OF FUTURE USAGES OF THE AREA TO YOUR ORGANISATION.

You are advised that the usage may not necessarily be approved nor the area be fit for the purpose for which your application has been made. Council draws your attention to the fact that the public risk policy held by council does not cover the liability that may accrue to your organisation for any accident or injury that may be sustained during the use of the council facility by your organization.
