One of Australia's toughest one day cycling race is coming through Glen Innes on Saturday 15 March! The 229km Grafton to Inverell Cycle Classic has a history of attracting top riders including Olympians and Tour de France competitors and now the action is heading our way.

Spectators can line Grey Street in Glen Innes to catch the excitement up close and support local businesses. The best viewing spot is on the western side of Grey Street between Wentworth and Meade Streets with riders expected between 9:15 AM and 2:00 PM.

A sprint point near the Australian Standing Stones and a Feed Station supported by local volunteers will add to the atmosphere being a key part of the race.
